The Society established its scholarship program in 2003, and the program continues to grow both in terms of support and scholarships awarded. In its first year of operation the program awarded 36 scholarships for a total of \$68,000; in 2007 we awarded \$700,440 to 332 students, with awards ranging from \$1,000 to \$3,000.
