Jennifer Elizabeth Metzger Memorial Scholarship (JEMMS)

In memory of a lost athletic student in a tragic vehicle accident, JEMMS is offering 2 scholarships. Candidates are required to write an essay on Safe Driving (which should be between 500-1000 words long). The essay must include the causes and effects of reckless driving and speeding and the devastating consequences. Also, the essay must include "who is Jennifer Metzger". Candidates should express good sportsmanship and their love for their sport should be evident as well. This scholarship is open to all students who are in their freshman to senior year. The candidates must be on a sports team in order to be eligible. Two scholarships will be awarded yearly in the amount of \$1,000.00 each (one time). If the recipient is an underclass man (not a senior) the monies will be held in the foundation account until the recipient becomes eligible to receive the monies. NJ Sharing Network

The New Jersey Sharing Network is offering two \$5,000.00 scholarships to high school seniors residing in New Jersey. NJ Sharing Network is an organization that educates and promotes the saving of lives through organ and tissue donations.
