AP Summer Institute 2017 Instructions for Online Registration

How to Register

1. Visit the district website at www.piscatawayschools.org. Select “*Community Pass Online Registration*” under **Quick Links** on the right side of the page.
2. **Existing Users and Previous Non-Piscataway Families:**
IMPORTANT: Please do not create a new account. In the Existing Users box on the right side of the page, enter the User Name and Password that you have used for previous registrations, such as Piscataway Summer Camp or Subscription Busing. If you do not remember your user name and password, call the Community Education Office at 732-572-4688 for assistance and you will be provided with your account information.
3. **New Users and Non-Piscataway Families:** Select **Create an Account**. Create your user name and a password, which can be any combination of letters and numbers. Next, create your family account. The name that you enter should be the primary contact name (such as a parent or guardian). All fields in red must be entered. Click “Continue.”
4. In “Browse Activities” select AP Summer Institute 2017, click “Continue.”
5. Verify the user account information, click “Continue.”
6. Verify your email address, click “Continue.”
7. Choose the child(ren) to register for AP Summer Institute, click “Continue.”
8. Verify your child(ren) grade and school, click “Continue.”
9. Select the class or classes for child(ren), click “Continue.”
10. Confirm your registration, click “Continue.”
11. Click “Finish” to complete your transaction, which will generate a confirmation to your e-mail address. Be sure to “log out” at the top right corner of the screen when you have completed your registration.
