Put differently, 256 Students in the Class of 2026 earned 90s or higher in at least 4 of their 8 classes! that you can stress to your child to help them avoid being in a hall sweep:

- > Go directly to your next class as quickly as possible
- > Avoid stopping in the halls to talk to your friends
- > If you have to go from one campus to another walk outside through the bus loop to avoid possible congestion in the hall
- > Always ask for a pass from your teacher if you are going to be in the hallway

Students and After-School Attendance

❖ Students who are on campus for a school-approved group or program must report to the group/program by 2:00 p.m. Students are subject to denial of entry into the group/program if they are not on time and a late bus pass will not be issued to that student. Students who are not attending a school-approved program must exit the school building at dismissal. Re-entry is not permissible.

Picking up your student early?

- Come to the main office closest to your student's classroom
- Bring Photo ID
- Only individuals listed in a student's Genesis contacts may retrieve a student early from school

The Dean's Corner - Reaching out with some FAQ's!

Q: What can I do if I have an issue with another student?

Q: What is the attendance policy at PHS?

A: Contact your Dean or your Counselor. Let your family know. Oftentimes, a mediation can resolve most issues. In all cases, do not add "gas" to the issue & try to ignore other students inserting themselves in the issue. A lot of what is spread around is just hearsay. Stay positive & true to you!

A: Students must not accrue more than 16 unexcused absences from school. When your student is absent, complete the <u>student absence form</u>, with an appropriate reason listed. A SAF is acceptable for an absence of no more than two consecutive days, twice per marking period. In all other circumstances (for consecutive absences of more than two days), a note signed by a licensed medical physician (or other appropriate documentation) must be provided disclosing the specific illness or injury preventing school attendance, and the specific days of absence.

Late Work Policy for Major Assignments

All long-term assignments (see course syllabus) submitted after the due date will be accepted & assessed a penalty of 10% for each consecutive school day late.

Any long-term assignment submitted after 5 consecutive school days will be evaluated by the teacher for the purpose of providing the student with feedback & a grade of zero will be recorded

No assignment will be accepted after 10 school days. It is the student's responsibility to communicate extenuating circumstances with their teachers, prior to the assignment's due date when possible

Short-term assignments (see course syllabus) guidelines will be at the discretion of the department. If a student is absent the day of an assessment, it is the student's responsibility to schedule a make-up assessment upon their return to class.
