Dear Parents and Guardians:

Your child has enrolled in *English IV: Expository Writing* for his or her Senior English class, and there are two summer assignments that must be completed. You should know:

- The Expos Summer Assignments are 100% mandatory. Students who do not complete the summer assignments for *Expository Writing English IV* will not be allowed to continue in the class in Fall.
- All students will need internet access and Google accounts; drafts, essays, and various other assignments must be submitted on Google Drive.
- Summer Assignments should be completed ON TIME, but will be accepted up to four days late with penalties. Each day late will incur a 20% penalty, until Day 5, when the work will no longer be accepted (**and the student will be removed from the class**). Due dates are below:
