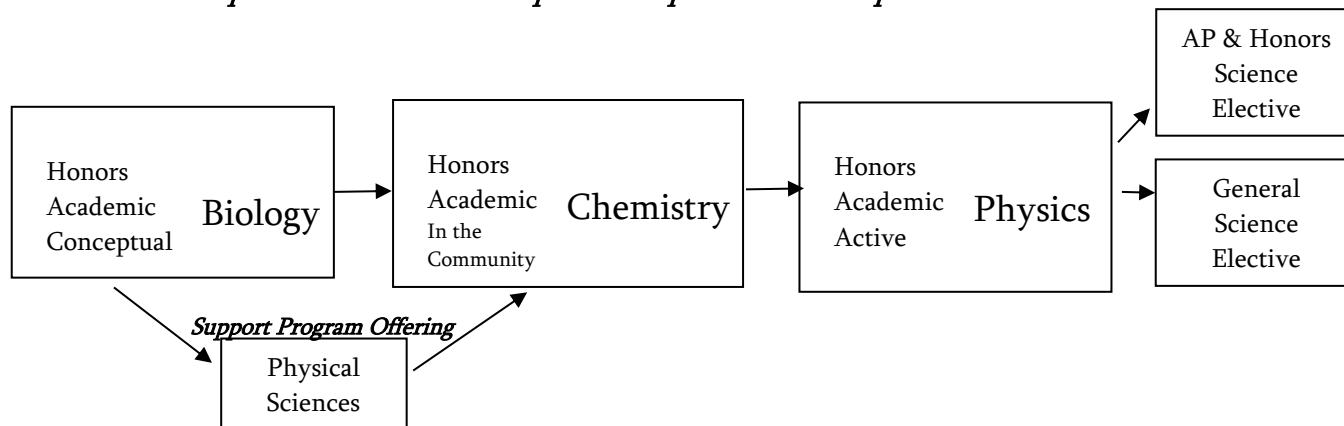


Common Science Course Sequence Pathway
